

Toronto Stamp's Photo ID service was designed with the security of your personnel data foremost in mind.

- 1. Personnel names and photos are typically transmitted to Toronto Stamp via eMail
- 2. The names and photos are downloaded from our proprietary eMail System to our password-protected computer system and the eMails immediately deleted
- 3. Names and Photos are inserted in your custom template and Photo ID Badges are printed
- 4. The Photo ID Badges are fabricated (i.e. trimmed, slotted, etc.)
- 5. The Photo ID Badges are inspected:
 - If OK the Photo ID Badge(s) layouts including name(s) and photo(s) are deleted from our computer system and the badges are forwarded to shipping
 - If not OK The defective Photo ID Badge is destroyed and another Photo ID Badge is printed/fabricated/inspected
- 6. Photo ID Badges are shipped



- Summary: Your Photo ID data is stored behind our firewall protected computer system for less than one day
 - Access to your password-protected data during the production cycle is restricted to either our Production Manager or Graphics Manager
 - Toronto Stamp does not retain any of your Photo ID data beyond the one day production cycle
 - Any replacement Photo ID Badges will require you to re-send the name(s) and photo(s)
