

- 1. Peel **Hour Sign** from backing sheet and turn it face upwards.
- 2. Remove desired time label from die cut **Time Label Sheet**.
- 3. Apply **Time Label** to **Hour Sign**, making sure it is properly aligned. Press down firmly.
- 4. Continue steps 2 and 3 until all times are applied.
- 5. Clean the inside of the window or door with a damp cloth leaving the glass wet.
- 6. Apply the assembled **Hour Sign** to the damp surface so that it can be read through the glass from the outside.

- 7. Squeegee off surplus moisture using stiff cardboard to bring the **Hour Sign** flat. Be careful not to distort or stretch the plastic. Make sure all air bubbles are removed.
- 8. Allow it to dry of it's own accord. This will give perfect adhesion.

The entire operation takes only a few minutes. **Time Labels** not in use can be stored on the backing sheet. **Hour Signs** and **Time Labels** can be used over and over again, giving years of useful life.
